The **INTERAC-TIC** research project aims to **reframe oral interaction within blended and online environments for second language teaching and learning**. INTERAC-TIC seeks to generate the knowledge required to determine the optimal setting for each component of oral interaction activities (task presentation, task execution, and task feedback). The project's findings will be instrumental in gaining a deeper understanding of how oral interaction develops in face-to-face, blended, and online contexts, and in creating a best-practice framework to provide teachers with guidelines on how to implement them.

Would you like to get involved?

To carry out this project, we are looking for foreign language teachers willing to implement activities designed by our team to develop online oral interaction in adult learners. If you decide to collaborate, you will have full access to our findings.

Collaborating with our project is straightforward; we simply need to:

- **Present the activities** we have prepared for B1 and B2 levels, providing any necessary explanations to help you decide which ones to implement and to establish potential dates.
- **Conduct a brief interview** prior to implementation to better understand your specific teaching context.
- **Administer two student surveys** (one before and one after the activities) alongside the implementation.
- **Meet for 15–20 minutes** after the project to discuss your experience.
